# COURSE DESCRIPTION



In observance of Oral Cancer Awareness Month, we would like to invite you to join us at the second Cook County Health Symposium on Oral Oncology on Thursday, April 4th, 2019. This symposium is a one-day course on the diagnosis, management and rehabilitation of the oral cancer patient. The meeting is geared towards dental and medical providers including general dentists, oral & maxillofacial surgeons, otolaryngologists, plastic surgeons, radiation and medical oncologists, and primary care providers. This symposium provides an overview and an update on the management of oral cancer, dysplasia, osteoradionecrosis and other related topics. The highlight of the program will be the keynote address by world renowned Dr. Richard Hayden, Arizona Mayo Clinic, who is an authority and one of the pioneers in the field of head & neck and reconstructive surgery. Our second keynote speaker, Dr. Andrew Schache, joins us from Liverpool, England with a European perspective on the treatment of oral cancers.

## Key Note Speakers:



Richard Hayden MD, FACS, Professor of Otolaryngology – Head & Neck Surgery joins us from the prestigious Mayo Clinic Scottsdale in Arizona, where he currently serves as the Director of Education at the Mayo Clinic Center for Regenerative Medicine. Dr. Hayden is world-renowned and considered an authority and one of the pioneers in the field of head & neck and reconstructive surgery. He has authored over 100 peer-reviewed articles and lectures nationally and internationally. His keynote address will discuss the reconstructive options for the oral cancer patient.



Andrew Schache PhD, MBChB, BDS, FDSRCS, FRCS joins from University of Liverpool, England. Dr. Schache is a clinical senior lecturer in Head & Neck Surgery at University of Liverpool Institute of Translational Medicine, and honorary consultant of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery at Aintree University Hospital. He has a PhD in molecular oncology and is the primary investigator on several funded clinical trials. His keynote address will be on the role of sentinel node biopsy in the treatment of oral cavity cancers.

This event will be held at our new state-of-the-art Cook County Health Professional Building, located on the John H. Stroger, Jr. Hospital campus.
