To qualify for Reserve Duty employment consideration in the Navy Dental Corps, you must:

1. Graduate a Dental School in the U.S., Canada, or Puerto Rico accredited by the ADA Council on Dental Education.
2. If it has been greater than 6 months after graduation, the applicant must be licensed. New graduates have one year to obtain a license.
3. Be a U. S. citizen.
4. Marital Status – No restrictions.
5. Be willing to serve a minimum of three years Reserve Duty.
6. Max age is 42.
7. Be in good physical condition and pass a full medical examination.

Reserve Officers serve part-time:

1. Serving part-time as a Reservist, your duties will be carried out during your scheduled drilling and training periods. During monthly drilling, Dentists in the Navy Reserve typically work at a location close to their homes. This gives you the flexibility to expand your dental experience in the Navy without compromising your civilian practice at home.

Job Description

1. For annual training, dentists may serve anywhere in the world, whether at sea, in hospitals stateside, or in bases and camps in countries around the world.
2. For the Navy Dentist, running an exceptional practice is a daily opportunity. They attend to Sailors, Marines and service members – as well as their families.
