IMPORTANT Pre-course Information:

**For ISOMS members/staff who have registered for the Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS) provider Course to be held Saturday, March 14, 2026:**

Please plan to arrive on time, because it will be difficult for late students to catch up once we start. Students are expected to attend and participate in the entire course.

Use the following steps to access the student resources:

1. Visit **elearning.heart.org/courses**
2. Find the course name (**ACLS Precourse Self-Assessment**)
3. Once you find the course, select **Launch Course** to begin.

*Note:* If you haven't already logged in, the system will ask you to do so. If you haven't visited the site before, you will be prompted to set up an account.

## **How to Get Ready**

The ACLS Course will teach you the lifesaving skills required to be both a team member and a Team Leader in either an in-hospital or out-of-hospital setting. Because the ACLS Course covers extensive material in a short time, you will need to prepare for the course beforehand.

## **Precourse Requirements**

You should prepare for class by doing the following:

1. Review and understand the information in your **ACLS Provider Manual**. Manuals can be obtained from **shopcpr.heart.org**. The current manual is the 2025 AHA ACLS Provider Manual; Product Number **25-1106**.
2. Review, understand, and pass the mandatory Precourse self-assessment online. **Print your certificate and bring it with you to class.**
3. Ensure that your BLS skills and knowledge are current for the resuscitation scenarios.
